



Citrus County School's Food and Nutrition Services will be participating in the Summer Feeding Program during the months of June and July.

Nutritionally balanced meals will be provided **FREE to All children 18 years old and younger** regardless of race, color, national origin, sex, age or disability. The Summer Feeding Program helps to bridge the gap during Summer vacation when school breakfasts and lunches are not available. The programs are only approved for geographical areas of need where 50 percent or more of the children qualify for free and reduced-price meals during the school year. The goal is to make sure no child goes hungry.
